Then you may be our new health professional project manager in our Learning Unit.

Your tasks

As project manager you will be responsible for managing and participating in projects in connection with the reporting scheme for health care errors (adverse health care events) and learning in the healthcare system. In addition, you will contribute to learning initiatives through analysis of relevant data and participation in the development of the Danish Patient Safety Database. Furthermore, you will be responsible for providing secretarial services for forums and committees and answering inquiries regarding the Danish Patient Safety Database from researchers, risk managers and the press.

Your qualifications

You should have a health professional background and thorough knowledge of healthcare and health organization. You are e.g. a medical doctor, master of public health, other relevant academic education or a nurse.

In addition, we emphasize that you:

- can navigate in a politically controlled organization
- are good at networking and collaborating
- are a strong written and oral communicator

Experience from a politically-led organization and with patient safety work is an advantage.
