

Free participation in PhD courses for guest PhD students from University of São Paulo

To support the strategic collaboration between research groups within the health sciences at Aarhus University and University of São Paulo it has been decided that guest PhD students from USP can participate free of charge in PhD short courses offered by the Graduate School of Health Sciences.

The decision is aligned with:

- Current agreements of international collaboration between the institutions exempting tuition fee for guest students and guest PhD students
- Joint projects in funding mobility between the institutions for students, PhD students, and staff
- Collaborations involving several research groups in diverse areas of health science and spanning several campuses at both USP and AU

Conditions

- Applicants must be enrolled as a PhD student at USP at the time of course participation and may be asked to document their enrolment.
- A timely and complete application according to the announced deadline is a condition – but not a guarantee – for a place at a specific course.
- Specific qualifications, terms and conditions might apply to specialized courses (see course listing for details).
- Participants receive a course diploma incl. ECTS (workload) if they complete the course to the satisfaction of the course leader.

- Any formal recognition or credit from USP will be at the discretion of the relevant body at USP.
- Participation is free of charge, but some courses might still require the participant to pay for materials; books; room and board; local transportation; etc. (see course listing for details).
- The PhD student is responsible for funding and arrangements regarding travel, housing, insurance, etc.
- Courses as well as seminars; symposia; conferences; etc. offered by affiliated institutions via the Graduate School are not included and may still require payment (see course listing for details).

Monitoring

Participation numbers will be monitored over a period of two years. Ideally PhD short course participation by guest PhD students from USP is balanced with PhD students from Aarhus receiving credit for – free – participation in PhD short courses at USP.

Revision

The Graduate School of Health Sciences, Aarhus University reserve the right to revise the conditions. Relevant bodies at USP will be duly notified of any such revision.
