

Instructions for Chairmen and Co-Chairmen for Poster Sessions at PhD Day 26 January 2018

At PhD Day 2018, there will be approx. 300 posters presented in 29 sessions. Each poster session has been assigned a Chairman (VIP) and two Co-Chairmen (3rd year PhD students).

As Chairman and Co-Chairman you are expected to:

- Read the abstracts for your session in advance and think of at least one or two questions you would like to ask during the presentations.

- Be at your poster session no later 10:00 am in order to divide the assignments between the Chairmen.

- Run the session - in English - between 10:15-11:45.
- Please visit each poster in your session and allow the presenter to give a 4 minute presentation followed by 2-3 min. for questions. Please keep the time.
- Fill in the form that you will be given at your session. You must acknowledge the presence of each student in the session.
- Choose the student who did best in your session. Please consider:
 - Intelligibility to someone outside the field of the PhD student
 - Layout (relation between text and illustrations)
 - Clarity (purpose, hypothesis)
 - Logical presentation
 - Enthusiasm
 - Please take into consideration how far into the project the student is
- Please note that both Chairman and Co-Chairmen have to sign the form.
- As quickly as possible, please return the form registration desk in the foyer of the Lakeside Lecture Theatres or to one of the many student helpers.
