## Call for applications for PhD Scholarships, Postdoctoral Fellowships and Visiting Professorships

---

The Danish Diabetes Academy (DDA) invites applications for:

- Four co-financed 2/3 PhD scholarships
- Three two-year postdoctoral fellowships
- Up to four visiting professorships/assistant professorships

The DDA also invites applications for co-financed PhD scholarships and co-financed postdoc fellowships where part of the remaining funding must be covered by the life sciences industry:

- Two 50%-financed two-year postdoc fellowships (a minimum of 25% of the remaining 50% funding must be covered by the life sciences industry)
- Three 1/3-financed PhD scholarships (a minimum of 1/3 of the remaining 2/3 funding must be covered by the life sciences industry)

Applications can be in any field of diabetes research. The DDA will prioritise applications that support the DDA's three major strategic areas (internationalisation, interdisciplinarity and collaboration across sectors).
