

Consul Johannes Fogh-Nielsen's and Mrs. Ella Fogh-Nielsen's Legacy

In January 2021, the Consul Johannes Fogh-Nielsen's and Mrs. Ella Fogh-Nielsen's Legacy will award DKK 100,000 or more for the continuation of excellent research by PhD students enrolled at Health, Aarhus University. The grant will be awarded at the annual PhD Day on 22 January 2021.

The grant is intended to support research projects implementing new studies based on published research results achieved during the PhD studies.

The following conditions must be met in order for the application to be considered:

- The grant can only be applied for once
- The grant is only available for PhD students in their final stage of the PhD study, i.e. students who expect to submit their dissertation by **07 October 2021** at the latest
- The applicant must be enrolled as a PhD student at Health on the date of application (enrolment terminates on submission of the dissertation)
- A prerequisite for applying is that the applicant participates in PhD Day on 22 January 2021 and has submitted an abstract for the day

All conditions must be met at the time of the application and be documented if possible.

Three candidates are selected on the basis of the applications, and they have to present their project as a short lecture on PhD Day. The Fogh Nielsen presentation excludes that the candidates participate with a regular poster/oral presentations or as a chairman in the PhD day. Ten minutes are allocated for the Fogh Nielsen presentation (in English), followed by five minutes for questions.

An appraisal of the presentation and the subsequent discussion will be included in the overall assessment. The grant is expected to be shared among the candidates on basis of the final assessment, which will be announced during the evening dinner on the PhD Day.

The application form *is obligatory to use* for the grant application and must be submitted no later than **Wednesday 7 October 2020 at 12:00** by emailing **a combined attached pdf file** to the Graduate School of Health: graduateschoolhealth@au.dk. Please state 'Fogh-Nielsen's Legacy' in the subject field. Alternatively, the application can be submitted in two printed copies to the Graduate School of Health, Katrinebjergvej 89F, 8200 Aarhus N.
