

## Consul Johannes Fogh-Nielsen's and Mrs. Ella Fogh-Nielsen's Legacy

In January 2023, the Consul Johannes Fogh-Nielsen's and Mrs. Ella Fogh-Nielsen's Legacy will award min. DKK 100,000 for the continuation of excellent research by PhD students enrolled at Health, Aarhus University. The grant will be awarded at the annual PhD Day on 20 January 2023.

The grant is intended to support research projects implementing new studies based on published research results achieved during the PhD studies.

The following conditions must be met for the application to be considered:

- You cannot previously have applied for the grant
- The grant is only available for PhD students in their final stage of the PhD study, i.e. students who expect to submit their dissertation by **06 October 2023** at the latest
- The applicant must be enrolled as a PhD student at Health on the date of application (enrolment terminates on submission of the dissertation)
- It is a prerequisite for applying that the applicant participates in PhD Day on 20 January 2023 and has submitted an abstract for the day (the abstract must be enclosed the application as documentation)

All conditions must be met at the time of the application and be documented if possible.

Three candidates are selected based on the applications, and will present their project on the PhD Day. Ten minutes are allocated for the Fogh Nielsen presentation (in English), followed by five minutes for questions. The Fogh Nielsen presentation excludes that the candidates participate with a regular poster/oral presentation or as a chair at the PhD day.

An appraisal of the presentation and the subsequent discussion will be included in the overall assessment. The grant is expected to be shared among the candidates on basis of the final assessment, which will be announced during at the dinner ceremony in the evening.

The application form *is mandatory to use* for the grant application and must be submitted no later than **Thursday 6 October 2022 at 12:00 (noon)** by emailing **a combined attached pdf file** to the Graduate School of Health: <a href="mailto:graduateschoolhealth@au.dk">graduateschoolhealth@au.dk</a>.
