

Instructions for Chairmen and Co-Chairmen for Oral Sessions at PhD Day 26 January 2018.

At PhD Day 2018, there will be approx. 30 oral presentations divided into 5 sessions. Each oral session has been assigned two Chairmen (VIP) and one Co-Chairman (3rd year PhD student).

As Chairman you are expected to:

- Read the abstracts for your session in advance and think of at least one or two questions you would like to ask during the presentations.

- Be at your oral session no later than 12:15, to divide the assignments between the Chairmen, and to answer any uncertainties from the presenters.

- Run the session - in English - between 12:30 - 14:00.
Each presentation is of 10 minutes followed by 5 minutes for questions. Please keep the time.
- Fill in the form that you will be given at your session. You must acknowledge the presence of each student in the session.
- Choose the student who did best in your session. Please consider:
 - The presentation is comprehensible to people outside the research area
 - Slides are easy to read and comprehend
 - The relationship between presentation and illustrations is obvious
 - Slides supports the presentation (and not just read aloud)
 - The purpose of the presentation (hypothesis) is clearly ahead
 - The content is presented in a logical sequence (progression)
 - The conclusion is unambiguous
 - The students enthusiasm
- Please note that both Chairmen and Co-Chairman have to sign the form.
- As quickly as possible, please return the form to the registration desk in the foyer of the Lakeside Lecture Theatres or to one of the many student helpers.
